

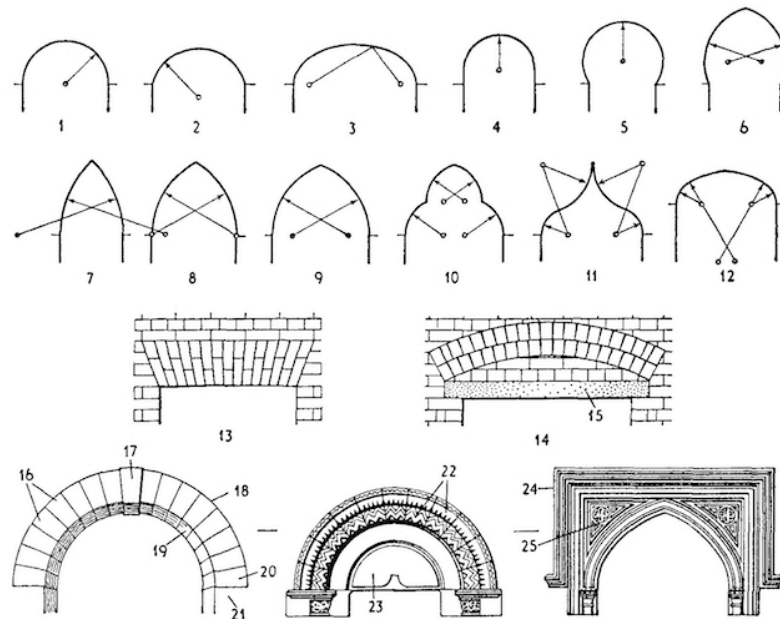
Senior Thesis: Capstone
