Technical writers work across many industries, including technology, healthcare, finance, engineering, and education. The demand for technical writers is projected to grow 6% by 2032, faster than the average for all occupations, according to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics.

- **High Salary Potential.** As of 2023, the median annual wage for technical writers is around \$78,060.
- **Job Growth.** Faster than the average for all occupations!
- **Remote Work Flexibility.** Many technical writing positions offer remote or hybrid work options.
- **Low Barrier to Entry.** Many employers are open to a variety of disciplinary backgrounds with evidence of effective writing.
